This role serves alongside laborers pioneering a work that integrates discipleship and community development within households of a neighborhood of 100 people groups. Responsibilities also include field research to assist leaders and laborers in addressing pain points with locally-made solutions. Applicants who value creation care, justice, and poverty alleviation are encouraged.

Must be a high school graduate with proficiency in English. The local team values ongoing spiritual formation and practices in its members and short-term practitioners. A degree in community development, change management, social entrepreneurship, or intercultural studies would be beneficial but not required.
